What's New

- Southwater Skate Park Now Open The official opening ceremony took place at Ben's Field, Stakers Lane on 31 July and despite the inclement weather local residents turned out to support it. Throughout the rebuilding process (after an unfortunate fire incident in August 2020) Southwater Parish Council actively engaged with the skate park users and a dedicated user consultation group to ensure the new park's design resonated with the community's needs and preferences. The hybrid structure of galvanised steel and timber promises and exciting riding experience and we hope that it will thrive as a place of friendship encouraging a healthy and active lifestyle.
- Recent Planning Applications
 - **DC/21/2180** Erection of up to 73 new dwellings (with affordable housing) at Woodfords, Shipley Road was approved by Horsham District Council Planning Committee North on 1st August where SPC made representation in objection to the proposed development.
 - DC/22/2077 Demolition of existing building and erection of buildings to provide flexible industrial, storage and distribution at RSPCA Headquarters, Oakhurst Business Park has been approved by HDC. 24-hour access was applied for which SPC had made representation in objection to and the development will now have conditions to restrict heavy goods vehicle movements.
- Southwater Summer Fest 2023 Southwater Summer Fest was a resounding success. It was very well attended and enjoyed by residents of all ages.
 Furthermore, Sussex Police and West Sussex Fire and Rescue were also in attendance. The idea was originally proposed by the Neighbourhood Wardens and actioned in partnership with Southwater Youth Project CIO and Southwater Community Partnership. Activities included a climbing wall, a live DJ, arts and crafts and gymnastics. Following the success, the aim is to host this event again next year.
