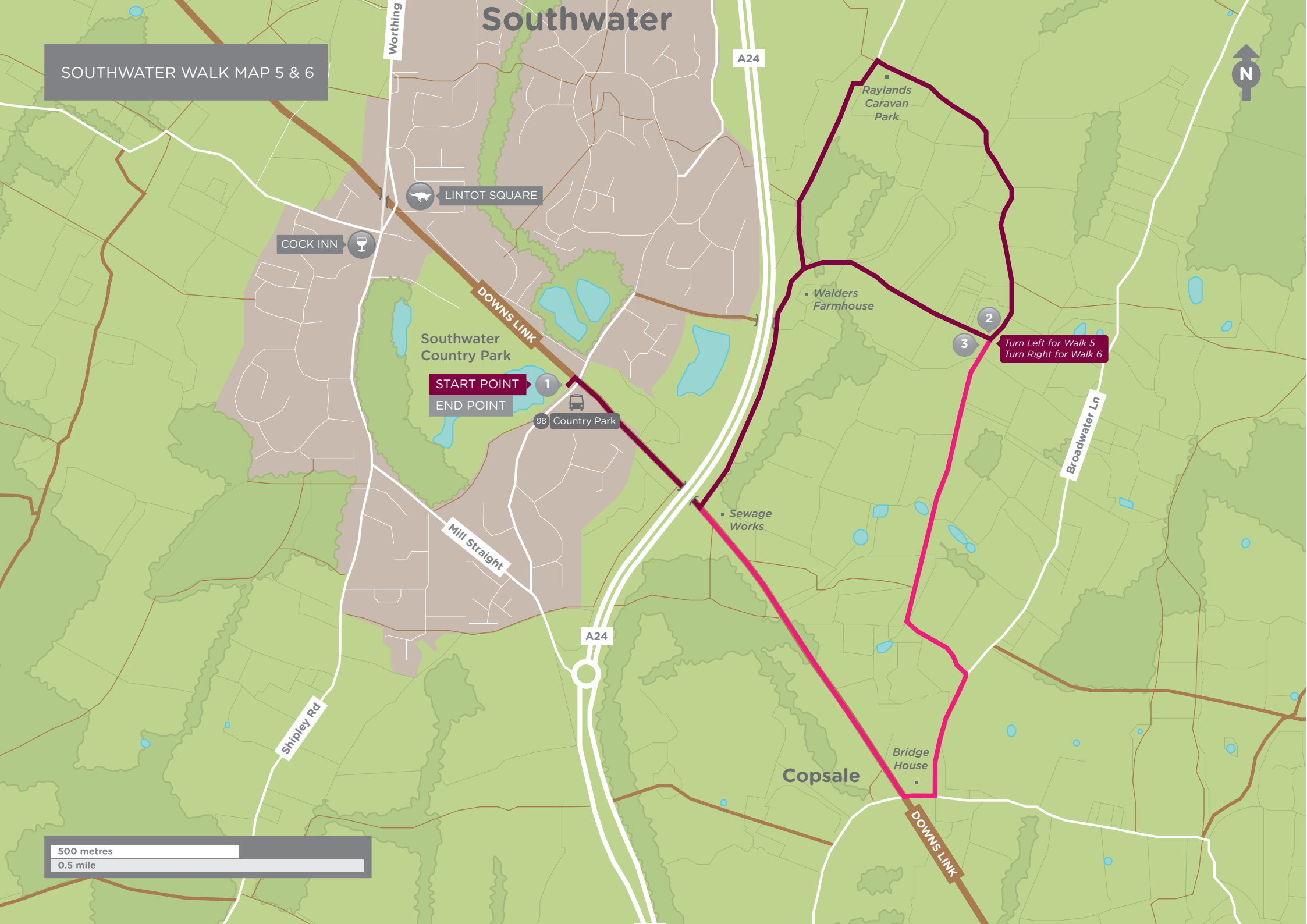

From the **Visitor Centre** walk towards the car park, turn right out to Cripplegate Lane and cross over into Stakers Lane. Proceed along to the tunnel under the A24. After the tunnel turn left walking parallel to the road along a concrete track. The sign PRIVATE applies to vehicles, this is a public bridleway. Follow the bridleway signs going around farm out-buildings and through a couple of gates. When **Walders Farmhouse** – a 15th century timber framed building – is directly to your right you come to a fingerpost at a T junction of paths. Bearing right continue over a footbridge. Proceed ahead following bridleway signs. Cross driveway and be sure to keep right by a bridleway fingerpost at the start of a post and rail fence (go between fence and tree). Continue across the field in direction of the fingerpost sign until reaching a second footbridge. Cross and continue along the bridleway between post and rail fences to junction with **Polecat Lane**.

For Walk 5 : Turn left and walk for 1km. Immediately after **Raylands Caravan** site, at a sharp right hand bend in the lane turn left onto a footpath and immediately go left again. This path leads behind the caravan park. After passing a big barn on your right go straight across a driveway leading to a house on your left. Continue for 130m to a T junction of paths. Turn left and go through a gap or over a stile bearing right into woodland. At a grass field keep to the left hand field edge. You will see ahead a finger post at which point bear right – the farm house is facing you. This is the bridleway that takes you around the outbuildings and back along the concrete track to retrace your route to the Visitor Centre.

For Walk 6 : Turn right and follow the lane all the way to the T junction with **Broadwater Lane** (almost 1km i.e. approximately ¼ hour.). Turn right and at next T junction turn right into **Bar Lane**. Pass the former **Bridge House Inn** site, marked by an old pub sign. Immediately after the pub's garden turn right onto the **Downs Link Path**. Follow this using the Downs Link finger posts as your guide all the way back to the car park adjacent to the Visitor Centre.

PLEASE NOTE:

This is not a Definitive Map. It is advisable to use O.S. Explorer Map 134 in conjunction with this guide. It is advisable to wear **stout footwear**. Please remember to follow the **Countryside Code**.
