PARISH COUNCILLORS' ALLOWANCES

Southwater Parish Council gives notice that it has received a report from the independent Parish Remuneration Panel making the following recommendations:

- That all Parish Councillors be entitled to receive a basic allowance of not exceeding £430 per annum (being 9.4% of the District Councillors' basic allowance)
- That no specific differential allowance be payable to chairmen of Parish Councils but this is without prejudice to payment of the chairman's statutory expense allowance under s15 of the Local Government Act 1972
- That each Parish Councillor may receive an allowance in respect of travelling and subsistence whilst on agreed parish duties. That allowance shall be in accordance with the Local Government Staff Scheme of Travel and Subsistence Allowances (modified in respect of mileage for Members' training purposes) adopted by Horsham District Council and modified by the recommendations at Para 7 of report..
